POSITION SUMMARY:

The Humanities Department at Toccoa Falls College invites applications for a full-time faculty position in the field of History starting August 1, 2024. Rank and salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. The position will primarily be tasked with the instruction and oversight of courses that are part of the History major but will be part of a Humanities department team that represents a diverse range of academic fields.

TASKS:

Teaching responsibilities will include courses in the areas of U.S. History, World History, Church History and Western Civilization. Academic advising and committee work are also expectations of the position.

SKILLS AND ATTRIBUTES:

Candidates should demonstrate experience in higher education, skills in curriculum design, a commitment to teaching excellence, ability to respond to the different needs of students, excellent interpersonal and group communication skills, and scholarly potential. Evidence of a vibrant Christian faith and a sincere commitment to the mission of Toccoa Falls College are essential.

EXPERIENCE & EDUCATION:

A master's degree in the field is a minimum requirement; an earned doctorate is preferred. Prior college teaching experience is desirable.
